Community Cars

Community Cars is a voluntary car scheme for members in BH1 to BH11 postcodes who need some help to get to appointments.

Volunteer drivers use their own cars and help you get to places such as GP surgeries, dentist, libraries, clubs, hairdressers and social clubs. *For wheelchair accessible vehicle – please ask about terms and availability.*

Cost : There is a joint Bat Bus/Community Cars annual membership fee of £10.00 . Mileage is charged at £0.60p per mile from the driver's home. A minimum charge of £5.00 per return journey .

Bookings must be made in advance on 01202 309433 as the scheme is much in demand.

Phone between 10am—2.00pm weekdays

The number of journeys may be limited at busy Times and we cannot guarantee that we can always provide a driver. **All drivers are police checked.**

'BAT' Bus Shopping Trips plus outings

What is the BAT Bus? The BAT Bus is a purpose built minibus with an accessible lift/ramp and steps Wheelchair passengers are able to travel in W/C.

Who can use the BAT Bus? Anyone who has difficulty using public transport, living in BH1 to BH11. Carers do not have to take out membership but are charged for a seat on the bus, or go freely if needed to push a wheelchair.

Where does the BAT Bus go?

Outings (see separate outings list) include visits to countryside pubs for lunch, garden centres, afternoon tea at cafés in interesting locations, trips to the countryside, New Forest and the Purbecks on Wednesdays & Saturdays. *£7.00 return* (some trips may attract a slightly higher price). Occasional Fish and Chip Fridays *£6.00 return*

Shopping trips go twice a week to Boscombe Sovereign Centre & Castlepoint Shopping Centres . *Shop-mobility* available at both. *£5.00 return*

Wimborne - *monthly service with pick ups from homes in Bournemouth, Canford Magna and Merley . £6.00 return*

How much will it cost? £10 membership per year applies and individual fares paid to driver when you travel.
